Re: INSURANCE PROTECTION FOR YOUR CHILD

2018/2019 School Year

Dear Parent(s):

Safety of our students is of utmost importance in the Buckeye Union School District. As such, the District takes appropriate steps to protect your child from injuries. Even so, accidents can and do happen while participating in activities that take place on campus, on school trips, and during extra-curricular activities and sports.

The Buckeye Union School District does not provide accident medical insurance for school-related injuries, which means you are responsible for all medical bills in the unfortunate circumstance that your child is injured during school activities. The student accident/health insurance plans offered by Myers-Stevens & Toohey & Co., Inc. may help you pay those bills.

Many coverage options are available, so please read their brochure carefully. The brochure is available on the District website (see information below) or from the school site secretary. You may limit coverage to school-related injuries only, or opt for 24/7 protection. The Student Health Care and High Option 24-Hour Accident plans are especially recommended for those students with no other insurance, as they provide the most help when injuries occur. Student Health Care covers illness as well as injury, 24 hours a day. The high option plans are recommended for students participating in interscholastic/extra-curricular sports.

If your child does have other health coverage, student insurance may also be used to help pay for eligible charges not covered by other insurance (i.e. deductibles and co-payments). The student insurance plans also allow you to take your child to the doctor or hospital of your choice.

Should you choose to participate in one of these student insurance plans, please complete the brochure's enrollment form available on the District website at <http://buckeyeusd.org/> under the links "For Parents" → "Information & Resources" → "Enrollment Information" → "Student Accident Forms", or from the school site secretary. Please enclose payment with your completed enrollment form and mail directly to Myers-Stevens & Toohey & Co. You will want to keep the brochure in a safe place in the event your child is injured.
