

2018 Preliminary LCAP Proposals
Presented to LCAP Parent Advisory Committee

Needs:

- Maintain and improve current program footprint
- Improve student achievement of at risk student subgroups
- Implement NGSS science curriculum
- Provide professional development for new science standards and curriculum
- Identify new K-5 standards aligned social studies curriculum
- Maintain and improve technology footprint
- Increase staffing to support increasing student enrollment at Valley View Charter Montessori
- Resource new Mandarin Immersion program
- Maintain and improve District communication tools

Proposals:

- District will continue to fund current program footprint adjusting for changes in enrollment. (Pending tentative agreement ratification, elementary P.E. Specialist service will increase from 120 minutes every 10 days to 180 minutes every 10 days.)
- Continue to refine and/or, as resources allow, increase services to at risk subgroups
- The District anticipates adopting a new science curriculum by June and implementation will commence with the 2018-2019 school year
- Professional development support (all grades) in science will need to be provided in 2018-2019

- New elementary social studies curriculum will be adopted by end of 2018-2019 school year
- 3000 Chromebooks are at end of life and need replacement. In addition, middle school science classrooms will need 1-to-1 device access to support new science curriculum
- 200 Classroom Doc Cameras (Elmos) are in need of replacement
- Valley View Charter Montessori is anticipated to increase enrollment by 100+ students and will need assistant principal support. Additional support services (e.g. counseling) will also be necessary for the site's staffing to remain equitable with other sites in the District
- Staffing and curriculum materials for Mandarin Immersion program. New enrollment is anticipated with creation of this new program
- District will launch parent app
- Reviewing emergency response communication tool for sites
