



Buckeye Union Board of Trustees -
Special Meeting - 7/31/2020

Recommendations

- 1) The Buckeye Union School District will reopen in Distance Learning to begin the first 6 weeks of school.
- 2) At the end of 6 weeks, which allows for the impacts of the Labor Day period to pass, if 1) case rates in our two boundary regions are below 100/100,000 for the previous 14 day period, and 2) a County virus testing program that can provide periodic testing to employees, and testing and results for symptomatic cases, in 24-48 hours, has emerged, and 3) with approval of the El Dorado County Public Health Officer, schools would reopen in a hybrid model or full-time model, to be decided upon by the Buckeye Union Board of Trustees.
- 3) Move the student start date from August 12 to August 17 in order for sites to set-up for Distance Learning.
- 4) Each site will convene a school site council and create a reopening plan that addresses both a hybrid and a full-time model.
