Many new brands have made their way to store shelves. It is our recommendation that you avoid the purchase of the following I.S.O.s (instrument shaped objects) – they are typically: foreign made, of poor workmanship, made out of “pot metal,” designed to be disposable, and accompanied by poor quality control and/or return policy. Most professional repairmen will not repair the instrument due to the low melting point, quality of metal and unavailability of parts. We choose not to service the I.S.O. brands listed below to avoid unnecessarily expensive, time-consuming, and frustrating repairs for both the customer and repairman. Thank you!
