The USDA waiver we were hoping for has arrived and we will be able to serve breakfast and lunch meals to every student at **no cost**. Starting Tuesday, September 8 you can go to [any of our sites](#) and pick up a weeks worth of breakfast and lunch meals.

We are happy to be able to provide these meals to help support our families and hopefully make things a little easier as your navigate your child's school day.

We are expanding our pick up hours to help accommodate your schedules. You can come by from 11-1 each Monday. Our pick up days are Mondays unless there is a holiday then we would serve on Tuesday.

- ◇ Most items will be frozen so you can cook at home for optimum freshness. Go to www.buckeyecafe.org for cooking/heating instructions and Food Safety information.
- ◇ This program has been extended through December 31 and we hope they will extend this waiver through the entire school year. We will communicate as we get notification.
- ◇ This program is available for anyone 18 and under (like we have done throughout summer)
- ◇ If you generally fill out an application for free/reduced meals, please submit your application. You can go to www.buckeyecafe.org and click on the apply online link. We still need to have this information in order for our district to receive funding for certain programs. Also, if the December 31 deadline is not extended you will already be approved in our system and there would not be a break in service.
- ◇ Our district is working on our reopening plan. Once we complete the process and know how we will be coming back to school, Food Services will communicate to you on how we plan to continue to feed and nourish your children.
