Buckeye Union School District is pleased to announce its partnership with Dream Enrichment Classes to provide all six elementary school sites, two days per week, extended learning opportunity classes for students beyond the regular school day. The District will be able to serve approximately eighty (80) students per week, at each elementary site. The program and enrollment will rotate every 10-12 weeks. There is NO COST to participate in the program. Transportation, a healthy snack, education, literacy, and enrichment elements are all part of the program.

Once registration requests have been processed, you will receive an email confirming your enrollment in the Session A Classes or, if capacity has been reached, notifying you of your placement on the waitlist, with priority for enrollment in the Session B Classes.
